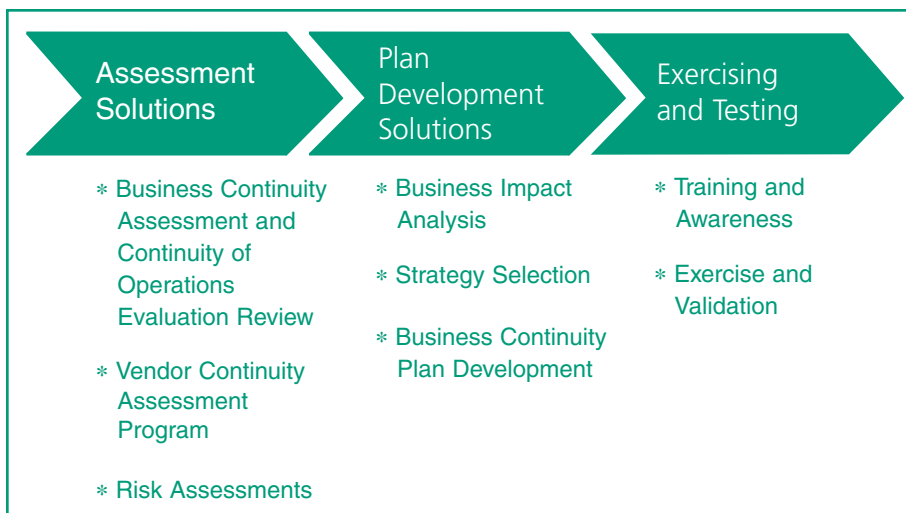


Our Web-based Business Continuity Assessment Program generates a “heat map” to help management identify where to target resources for improvement.

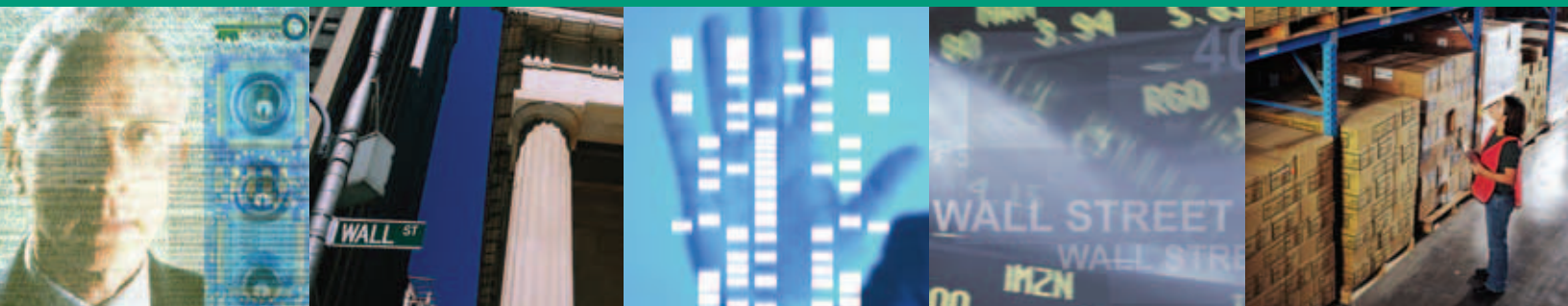
