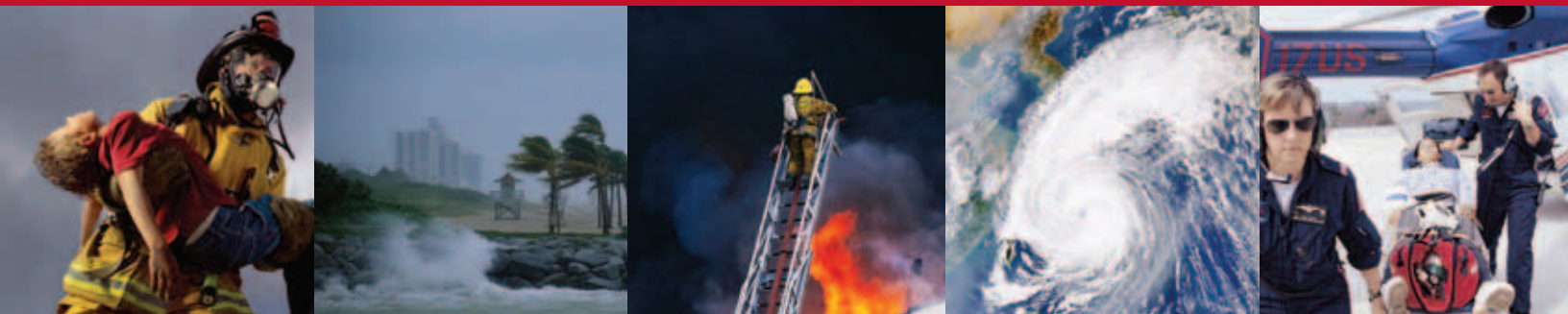
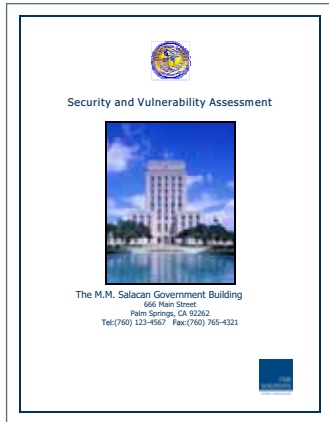

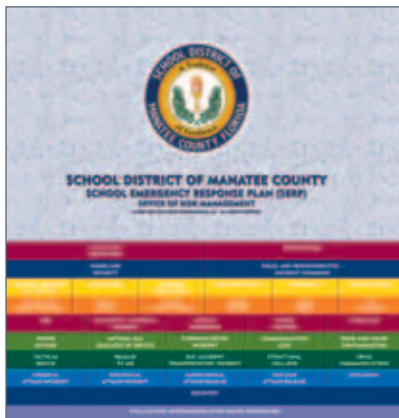


EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

All-hazards emergency and crisis response plans elevate compliance to NIMS, NFPA, ICS, and ICP standards.

Emergencies have become a predictable part of corporate, government, and school operations. Disasters like Hurricane Katrina have indelibly changed common assumptions and expectations—and demonstrated that the ability of most organizations to manage catastrophes is grossly inadequate. Government officials, executives, board members, and educators are now expected to anticipate emergency disruptions—natural, made-made, and terrorist related. Markets, public opinion, and the courts punish companies that do not adequately protect their people, physical assets, information, and supply chains. Standards of informed planning are beginning to affect the liability risks to which organizations are exposed. President Bush has even elevated emergency planning to a national security priority.

They must conform to federal standards in order to optimize inter-agency coordination. 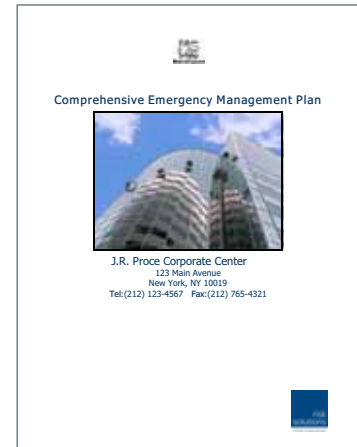
